Players competing from the Semi Final matches onwards are to attend for their matches dressed according to the Dress Code. Matches before the Semi Final stages, players are to attend for their matches dressed in trousers/jeans(no shorts/bermudas), shirt/polo shirt and shoes/trainers {no slippers(krakar)}. Failing to do so, the player involved shall lose his/her match as a walkover.

You are kindly requested to clean the table before every match.

After each match the winner is to inform the MBSA with the result by sending a message on mobile No. **79999147** stating names of players, result and venue of the match. Failure to do so by 12.00am (midnight) of match day will render the player concerned liable to a 10 euro fine.
