The club where each match is to be played should provide a referee, but if this is not possible it will be the players themselves to officiate the match. The MBSA will provide a Referee for the Semi-Finals and the Final.

Players competing from the Semi Final matches onwards are to attend for their matches dressed according to the Dress Code. **Matches before the Semi Final stages, players are to attend for their matches dressed in trousers/jeans(no shorts/bermudas), shirt/polo shirt and shoes/trainers {no slippers(krakar)}.** **Failing to do so, the player involved shall lose his/her match as a walkover.**

You are kindly requested to clean the table before every match.

After each match the winner is to inform the MBSA with the result by sending a message on mobile No. **79999147** stating names of players, result and venue of the match. Failure to do so by 12.00am (midnight) of match day will render the player concerned liable to a 10 euro fine.
